

Conway's Education Support Fund for refugees

The Conway's Education Support Fund for refugees and asylum seekers is a very small fund that aims to support asylum seekers and refugees to access educational courses. The fund is provided for through individual fundraising by Conway Education Centre volunteers and supporters. All monies raised for this fund will be used to make awards. No money is taken for administration or management of the fund.

CEC envisage making three or four awards this year (2016) and hopes to increase this in future years through continuing fundraising.

Application criteria:

1. Applicant has to provide evidence of Asylum seeker / Refugee status
2. Application has to be for an educational course, this can be community based or a further education course (FE course) or transport costs to enable applicant to access the course.
3. If request is made for transport cost, the award will be paid out on proof of education course enrolment. (Letter of acceptance)
4. There is a maximum award of £150
5. Applications can be made at any time and will be assessed within three weeks
6. Decision-making panel will be three CEC Trustees. The centre manager will prepare assessments and liaise with applicant and their supporter
7. If the application is for part funding, confirmation is required from other funders/contributors
8. As the fund is very small, successful applicants cannot apply again.
